Education Assistance Programs

Tuition Reimbursement

- Available to all who commit to working as an Radiology Technologist.
- You must be employed in an occasional, part-time or full-time capacity (0.3 FTE or greater)
- You can receive up to \$1,250 per semester, maximum \$2,500 per calendar year
- You must be employed for at least six months and have overall performance rating of at least a "meets expectations" to qualify.
- Repay the obligation through employment at a rate of one year of service for each semester paid. Service time is measured after you receive your degree and license.

Loan Payment Benefit Program

- Available to full-time (1.0 FTE) Radiology Technologist.
- Eligible to receive the maximum loan payment benefit of \$10,000 over a 3 year period.
- You must have a permanent unrestricted Radiologic Technologist license in the State of Louisiana.
- You have completed hospital orientation, departmental orientation, and receives at least a "meets expectations" score on your introductory period evaluation as a Radiology Technologist
- You must have an outstanding loan balance.
- Maximum payment is \$300 a month up to \$10,000 over a three year period.
- Payments are made directly to your lending institution.



Externship Programs

Radiology Tech Assistant

- Allows Radiology Technology student to gain real life experience. The Radiology Technology student assists in the performance of duties involved with a variety of technical and clerical procedures related to diagnostic radiology under the direction of a licensed Radiology Technologist. This includes:
 - Technical duties such as:
 - Aides patients that need assistance.
 - Assist with the transporting and moving of patients when needed.
 - Assists in performing Radiology exams.
 - Compiles patient requisitions for interpretation by the radiologist.
 - Insures adequate supplies items necessary for exams are available and prepared.
 - Clerical duties such as:
 - Accepts and stores various department medical supplies.
 - Assist in the file room.
 - Helps to maintain the department and equipment cleanliness.
- Accrue Paid Time Off (PTO)! Accrue at a rate of 0.05 hours of PTO for every
 productive hour worked up to a maximum of 120 hours per year. This PTO
 is available for use as soon as you start in a full-time Radiology Technologist
 position!
- Typically works between 16 and 24 hours in a two week period.
- Flexible work times to accommodate your class schedule.
